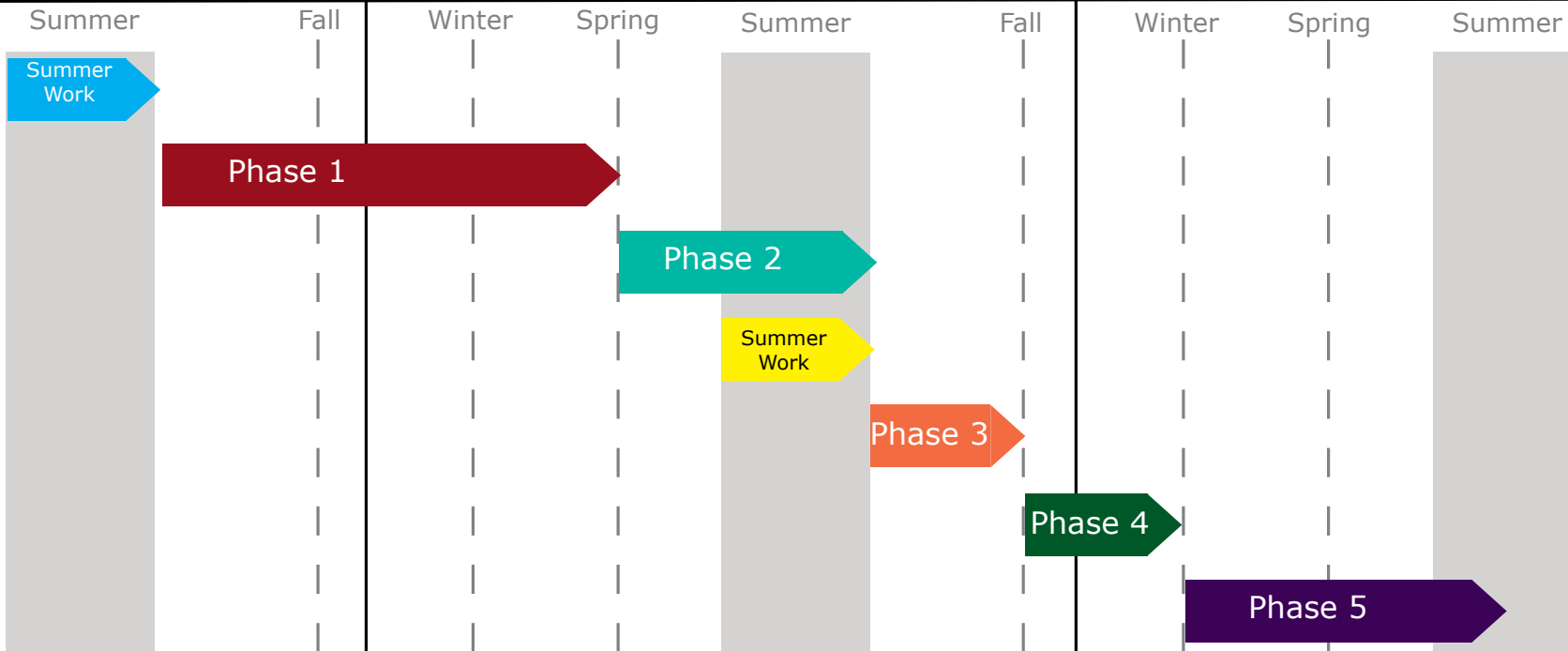


West Middle School Construction & Renovation 2021-2023

- Replacing key mechanical equipment, 6th grade expansion & related arts renovations begin, staff parking area added on NW side of building.
Impact: Building is effectively closed for the summer. South connector road closed between bridge and Odell St.
- Mechanical equipment back online, work continues on related arts area & 6th grade expansion.
Impact: Door #6 closed. Traffic in the connector road between Cardinal/DT and West will be one way going West. Related arts classes moved to new locations.
- Front entrance addition & reconfiguration begins. Cafe & kitchen renovation & performing arts expansion begin. Related arts renovations reopen, 6th grade expansion continues.
Impact: Cafe, kitchen & stage close and meals are served in temporary space in auxiliary gym. Front drive off Odell and door #1 both closed for pickup/dropoff. All visitors enter through a temporary door #1. Visitor parking will be in the new northwest lot. Door #6 reopens. New pickup/dropoff door is #23 at south end of the building.
- Remodel of existing 6th grade classrooms begins. Front entrance remodel continues and now includes portion of front office. Performing arts expansion continues.
Impact: Door #14 closed.

- Work in 6th grade wing and front office is now complete. Work on cafe, kitchen, stage, front entrance, & performing arts expansion continues.
Impact: Meals still served in temporary cafe in auxiliary gym and all visitors enter through temporary door #1, pickup/dropoff door is #23 at south end of the building.
- Full service to the cafe & kitchen returns, stage remains closed. Front entrance and performing arts expansion continue.
Impact: All visitors enter through temporary door #1, pickup/dropoff door is #23 at south end of the building.
- New performing arts expansion area open, front entrance re-opens, front drive re-opens. Existing performing arts area undergoes remodel with pickup/dropoff remaining at door #23 through the end of the 22-23 school year.
Impact: Performing arts classes move to alternate spaces.
